Position Description

Supervisor: Volunteer Coordinator

Purpose:

The Group Facilitator provides a facilitating role within a support group ensuring a supportive and safe atmosphere for those seeking support from us.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- ❖ Donate your time including but not limited to time spent preparing for group.
- **!** Encourage participation in the discussions of the group.
- ❖ Inform the Volunteer Coordinator and Director of any verbalization of suicidal intent (not ideation).
- ❖ Maintain confidentiality.
- ❖ Collaborate with co-facilitator in planning for each weekly group.
- ❖ Model genuine compassion, empathy, and open-minded responses within group.

Opportunities:

- Increase group facilitation skills and experience.
- ❖ Gain additional knowledge regarding issues faced by survivors of abuse and sexual trauma.
- ❖ Attend monthly ongoing training on abuse, sexual trauma and group facilitation.

Time Commitment: A minimum of 2 hours per week.

Age Requirements: At least 18 years of age.

Qualifications: Training is provided (A minimum of 10 hours classroom & reading).

Background check: Required (most locations \$19 paid by volunteer).

Dress Code: Casual
